Adi Kailash, also known as Shiva Kailash, Chota Kailash, Baba Kailash or Jonglingkong Peak, is a mountain located in the Himalayan mountain range in the Pithoragarh district of Uttarakhand, India. It is the abode of Lord Shiva, his consort Maa Parvati and their offspring Lord Ganesha and Lord Kartikey. The road to reach Mount Adi kailash was opened in the year **2020** which is an offroad ride loved among the adventure seekers and devotees. The whole area comes under the Vyas Valley named after the famous **Vyas Rishi**.





PARVAT

Situated at the heart of Vyas Valley is located the Parvat. A natural phenomenon where the top of the mountain has the shape of ॐ engraved in it. It is a sight to behold for everyone. It is a famous destination amongst the devotees and adventure seekers. You'll be riding along the river kali which enters in India through Kalapani. It is a great opportunity for the adventure seekers because the lands are untouched by the western influence and the real life on the mountains can be displayed by the locals.

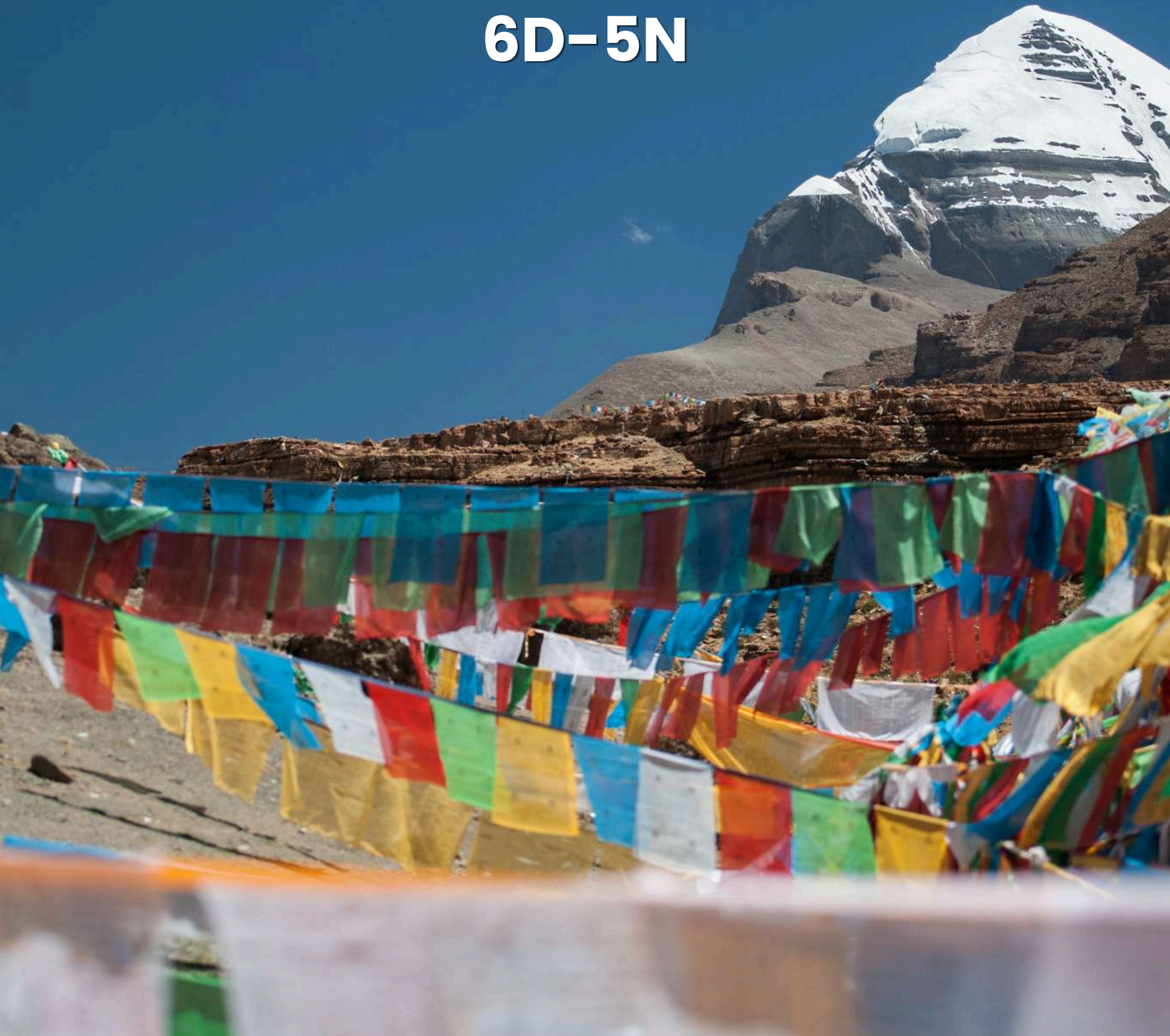

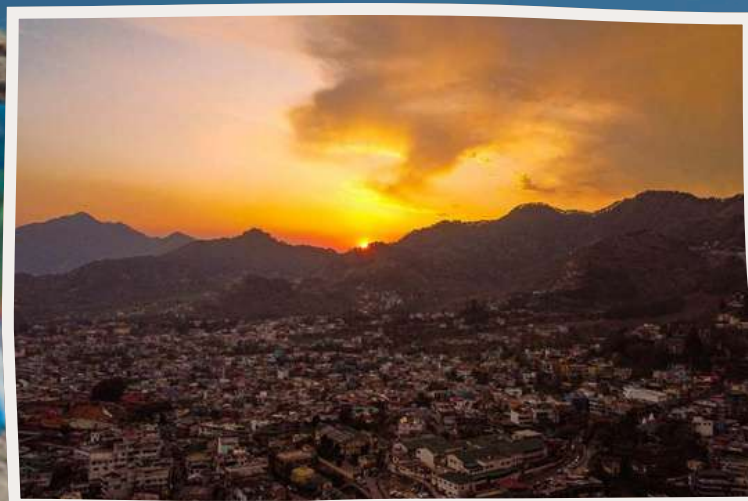

DAY -1 DEPARTURE

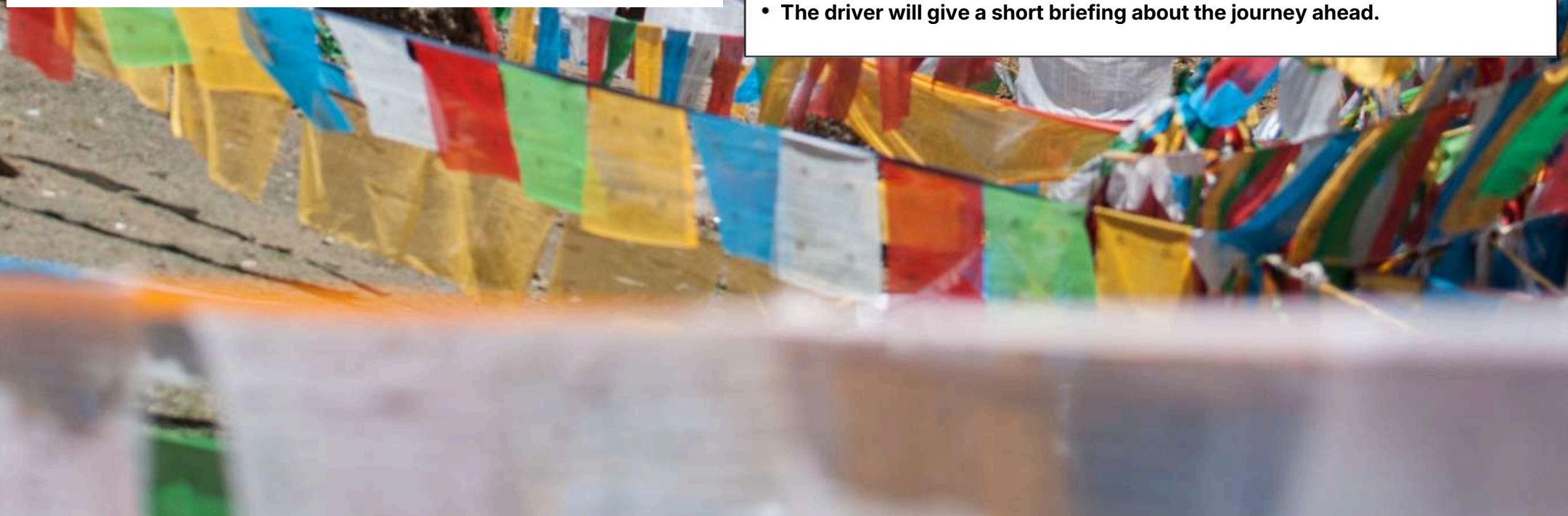


- **Meet the group at the departure point around 8:00 AM. Please note that the exact time and location may vary depending on your group – details will be shared with you in advance.**
- **A team member will be present at the departure location to assist you.**
- **The journey to Pithoragarh takes approximately 10–12 hours, depending on the route and traffic. Stay patient, keep your bellies full, and your spirits high!**
- **Use this time to get to know your fellow travelers – it's the start of an amazing shared experience.**
- **You'll reach Pithoragarh by evening, where you'll meet the rest of the team.**
- **Check in at the hotel and take some time to rest and freshen up.**
- **After dinner, the organizer will introduce you to your trip leader and conduct a briefing for the journey ahead.**

DAY -2 ENTER VYAS VALLEY



- Wake up and freshen up for a long journey ahead.
- Have a hearty breakfast and load your bags into the designated vehicles.
- The drive will take approximately 7–8 hours, depending on the route.
- Enjoy the peaceful and captivating scenery—don't forget to click some beautiful pictures along the way!
- Lunch break near Budi Village or Pangu Village—a perfect time to stretch your legs and enjoy local flavors.
- After crossing the Army Checkpost at Chiyaleikh, you officially enter the Vyas Valley.
- The drivers and tour operators will share fascinating local stories and folk tales along the way.
- Reach Nabhi by evening and check in to your hotel.
- Take some time to rest or enjoy a stroll around the peaceful village.
- After dinner, relax and enjoy the evening with your fellow travelers.
- The driver will give a short briefing about the journey ahead.



DAY - 3 ADI KAILASH DARSHAN



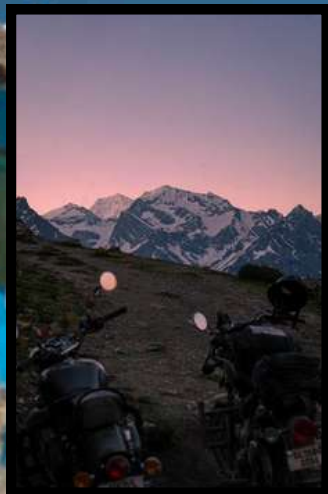
- Wake up early, enjoy a wholesome breakfast, and begin your journey to Jolinkong, the base of Mt. Adi Kailash.
- On the way, you'll pass through Kooti, the last inhabited village in the region — a glimpse into life at the edge of civilization.
- You'll visit two sacred lakes (kunds):
 - Maa Parvati Kund, located near her temple
 - Maa Gauri Kund, situated at the base of Mt. Adi Kailash
- The walk to the kunds is approximately 3 km one way. Due to the high altitude, the trek may feel challenging — take it slow, conserve energy, and breathe steadily.
- Be sure to carry snacks and water for the journey, especially for emergency needs.
- By evening, you'll arrive at the village Nabi, where you will rest for the night.



DAY-4 ॐ - PARVAT

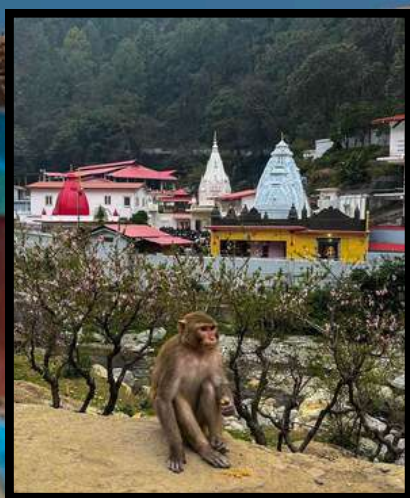


- Awaken to the gentle embrace of the morning, ready to uncover the hidden natural wonders that await.
- Begin your day with a visit to the awe-inspiring OM Parvat — a rare natural marvel where snow forms a perfect 'ॐ' (Om) symbol on the mountain's surface. A truly spiritual and breathtaking sight to behold.
- Take a moment to soak in the serenity, offer your gratitude, and capture this once-in-a-lifetime view.
- As the day unfolds, bid farewell to the majestic valley. Let the beauty of the landscapes accompany you on your journey back — soak in the views, take plenty of photos, and carry the peace of the mountains in your heart.
- It's now time to head back to Pithoragarh, where your memories of the sacred journey will begin to settle into stories worth retelling.



DAY -5 BHIMTAL /KAINCHIDHAM

- Wake up early and fuel up with a heavy breakfast — it's going to be a long and spiritually rich day.
- Check out from your hotel and bid farewell to the serene beauty of Soar Ghati. Take a moment to soak in the last views and crisp mountain air.
- By noon, arrive at the revered Chitai Golu Dev Mandir, known for its thousands of bells and handwritten letters of prayer hung around the temple.
- Spend some peaceful time exploring and maybe even pen down your own wishes.
- Enjoy a relaxed lunch en route or at a nearby dhaba/local restaurant.
- Post-lunch, head towards the spiritual haven of Kainchi Dham Mandir, founded by Neem Karoli Baba.
- Take time to absorb the calm energy of this famous ashram surrounded by hills and forest.
- By evening, reach the tranquil lake town of Bhimtal.
- Check into your stay and rest up after the day's soulful journey.

- Wake up leisurely — no rush today, as it's the last day of the trip.
- Freshen up and head down for a light, relaxed breakfast with the group.
